If western estimates of the prevalence of autism are applicable worldwide, then approximately 60 million people are currently affected directly by ASD, with many more affected indirectly. Most of these individuals are adults, but this is precisely the group that receives the least intervention, services, and support. This talk will outline the considerable challenges involving in remediating this situation worldwide.
